Adults account for almost two thirds of pedestrian casualties and 89% of pedestrian fatalities in the north east – around half are agent 16-35.

The majority of adult pedestrian casualties in the north east occur in CIV and COM CENTE areas.

The most common factors leading to adult pedestrian casualties include failing to look properly and being impaired by alcohol.
