

# Check out for people stepping out

Cars are involved in almost three quarters of adult pedestrian casualties in the north east.

The majority of adult pedestrian casualties in the north east occur in city and town centre areas.

Just over half of all adult pedestrian casualties are to some extent the fault of the person driving the vehicle that hit them.

The most common factors leading to adult pedestrian casualties include drivers failing to look properly and driving carelessly or recklessly.
