

Adults account for almost two thirds of pedestrian casualties and 89% of pedestrian fatalities in the north east – around **half are aged 16-35.**

The majority of adult pedestrian casualties in the north east occur in **city and town centre areas.**

The most common factors leading to adult pedestrian casualties include **failing to look properly** and being impaired by alcohol.
